temperature inversions in Punjab, coupled with emissions from crop burning, industrial activities, and brick kilns, exacerbate the smoggy conditions, creating a hazardous environment detrimental to public health.

Despite efforts to address air pollution, such as banning crop burning and initiating public transportation projects, the air quality continues to deteriorate, signaling the inadequacy of current measures. The gravity of the situation is underscored by data from the Pakistan Air Quality Initiative, estimating that hazardous air quality is reducing the life expectancy of Pakistan's inhabitants by an alarming 4.4 years.
