Difference Between "In," "On," and "At"

| Preposition | Usage | Example |
|--------------------|---|--|
| in | used to indicate a location within a larger space or a general time period | "She lives in New York City." or "I usually work in the morning." |
| on | used to indicate a surface or a specific date or day | "The book is on the table." "My birthday is on December 12th." |
| at | used to indicate a specific point in time or a specific location | "I will meet you at 3 PM." or "I am at the airport." |
