Therefore, The correct answer is (a) because it is the result of the condition stated in the sentence.

Three Types Of Conditional Sentences:

Sure, here is the grammar structure for each of the three types of conditional sentences:

Simple Conditional Sentences First Conditional.:

If + present tense, future tense

Example: If it rains tomorrow, we will cancel the picnic.



Complex Conditional Sentences Second Conditional.:

If + past tense, conditional tense

Example: If I won the lottery, I would buy a house on the beach.

Mixed Conditional Sentences Third Conditional.:

If + past perfect tense, conditional perfect tense

Example: If I had studied harder, I would have passed the test.

Here are ten examples of each of the three types of conditional sentences:

Simple Conditional Sentences (First Conditional):

If + present tense, future tense

- 1. If you water the plants, they will grow.
- 2. If it snows tomorrow, we will go skiing.

- 5. If she starts early, she will arrive on time.

- 9. If you study hard, you will do well on the exam.
- 10. If they practice regularly, they will improve their skills.



Complex Conditional Sentences (Second Conditional):

If + past tense, conditional tense

- 1. If I won the lottery, I would buy a house on the beach.
- 2. If you invited him to the party, he would probably come.
- 3. If I had more time, I would learn a new language.
- 4. If she lived closer, we could see each other more often.
- 5. If it wasn't so expensive, I would buy a new car.
- 6. If he worked harder, he would get a promotion.
- 7. If I were you, I would take the job.
- 8. If it rained, we would stay inside.
- 9. If you gave me your phone number, I could call you.
- 10. If you asked her, she would help you.

Mixed Conditional Sentences (Third Conditional):

If + past perfect tense, conditional perfect tense

- 1. If I had studied harder, I would have passed the test.
- 2. If she had left earlier, she would have avoided traffic.
- 3. If he had listened to the instructions, he wouldn't have made a mistake.
- 4. If we had gone to the beach, we would have seen the dolphins.
- 5. If I had known you were coming, I would have baked a cake.
- 6. If you had asked me, I would have helped you.
- 7. If she had told me the truth, I wouldn't be angry.
- 8. If he had saved more money, he could have retired earlier.
- 9. If I had finished the project on time, I wouldn't be so stressed.
- 10. If they had invited us, we would have gone to the party.
