- 1. Date of Voting on No-Confidence Motion in NA: 3 April 2022
- 2. NO-Confidence Motion Rejected on: 3 April 2022
- 3. PM Pakistan Imran Khan advised President Pakistan to dissolve NA on 3 April 2022
- 4. President Dr Arif Alvi on 3 April 2022 dissolved the National Assembly on Prime Minister Imran Khan's advice under Article 58 of the Constitution.
- 5. Strength Needed for Success of NO-Confidence Motion: 172/342
- 6. PDM (Pakistan Democratic Movement) Coalition of 13 Political Parties
- 7. Motion of NO-Confidence presented by opposition parties on: 8 March 2022
- 8. After the dissolution of the NA assembly, fresh elections in the country will be held within 90 days.
- 9. Under Article 224 of the constitution, the prime minister will continue his responsibilities, the Cabinet has been dissolved.
- 10. According to Article 58, "The President shall dissolve the National Assembly if so advised by the prime minister; and the National Assembly shall, unless sooner dissolved, stand dissolved at the expiration of forty-eight hours after the prime minister has so advised."
