
The twinkling of stars is caused by the passing of light through different layers of a turbulent atmosphere. Most scintillation effects are caused by anomalous atmospheric refraction caused by small-scale fluctuations in air density usually related to temperature gradients.

Atmospheric Refraction

The atmospheric refraction is the **phenomenon** that is the reason for the twinkling of stars. The air that is present in the atmosphere is a dense fluid that is spread out over the region. It is **responsible** for bending of the light beam that comes through the **stars**.
