Correct Answer: Answer: A) 4

Explanation:

To divide decimals, you can treat them as whole numbers by moving the decimal point the same number of places to the right for both the dividend and the divisor.

In this case, moving the decimal point two places to the right for both 0.8 and 0.2 gives you 8 and 2, respectively.

Dividing 8 by 2 gives you 4, so the result of dividing 0.8 by 0.2 is 4.
