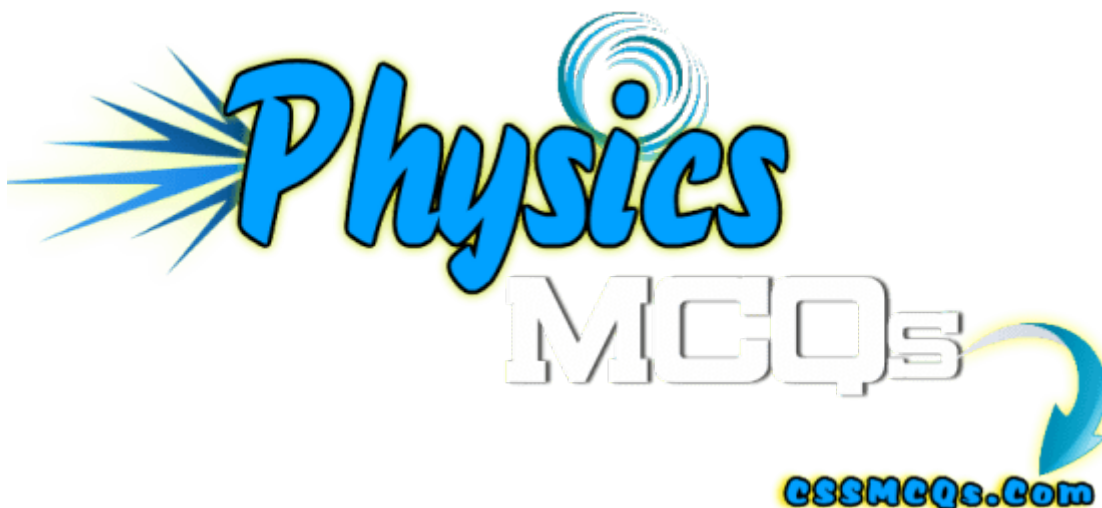
What is Impulse?
