The Pakistan Water & Power Development Authority is a government-owned public utility maintaining power and water in Pakistan. WAPDA does not manage thermal power. It includes Tarbela and Mangla dams among its resources. Its **headquarters** are in **Lahore**. It was found on **February 22, 1958**
