children born as refugees between 2018 and 2022_{-}^{1} .

It's not just high-income countries shouldering the responsibility. Approximately 76% of the world's refugees and other people in need of international protection are hosted in low- and middle-income countries, demonstrating the significant role these nations play in providing asylum¹. Moreover, 70% of refugees live in countries neighbouring their countries of origin, indicating the propensity for displaced individuals to stay within their geographical region if possible¹.

Despite the daunting figures, there's a glimmer of hope. In 2022, some 453,600 refugees were able to return to their countries of origin or were resettled, offering a ray of hope amidst the crisis¹. However, the plight of the 4.4 million stateless people, who are neither considered nationals by any state nor qualify as refugees, continues to be an urgent concern¹.

In conclusion, while Türkiye stands as the country hosting the largest refugee population, the overall landscape of the refugee crisis demands collective global action. The need for effective strategies to assist displaced populations, from repatriation to resettlement, is evident. It's essential that we continue to shed light on these issues and work together to create sustainable solutions for the millions affected by displacement worldwide.
